Privacy Policy

Rustomjee (that is, our subsidiaries, our ultimate holding company and its subsidiaries) ("we", "our", "us") are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This privacy policy (together with our terms of use and any other documents referred to on it) sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it. We May Collect And Process The Following Data About You:

Information you give us. You may give us information about you by filling in forms on our sites, or by submitting your CV, or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise or, by you interacting with any of our business partners, suppliers or sub-contractors (including estate agents, sales agents and our professional advisors) engaged on our behalf. This includes information you provide when you register to use our sites, subscribe to our service, email us, arrange property viewings with us, request brochures from us, complete an enquiry form, provide your CV and when you report a problem with our sites.
